It is important to note that the Greenwich Public Schools Office of Human Resources is charged with ensuring all employees abide by Board of Education Policy as well as state and federal laws. The intent of this investigation was to determine if an employee violated Greenwich Public Schools Board of Education Policy, and if so, to recommend discipline. When this was brought to the attention of the administration, the employee was immediately put on administrative leave and the investigation of his actions began.

There was no question that the Chief of Human Resources could fully and appropriately investigate the situation. The Chief began his appointment to this GPS position just weeks before and has served extensively as a senior administrator in high level positions. There was no conflict of interest whatsoever. In matters such as these, we always involve legal counsel.

It was also quickly announced that the Attorney General, Town of Greenwich, CHRO, and the Connecticut State Department of Education would be investigating the issue or system as a whole. We assured all of those agencies that any and all information would be made available to them with our intent to fully comply.

The district has cooperated in full with each of the investigations and hope to receive those reports when completed. To date, we have provided over 50,000 pages of documents as requested, including our report from Human Resources, and helped provide approximately 100 hours of teacher and administrator interviews from across our district.

Most of the questions you have asked will undoubtedly be answered through the other investigations of our system hiring practices.

Greenwich Public Schools is extremely proud of our administrators and teachers and the work they do on a daily basis to maintain the highest standards of professional conduct.
